

What is Social Emotional Learning?

Social-emotional learning (SEL) is an integral part of education and human development. SEL is the process through which all young people and adults acquire and apply the knowledge, skills, and attitudes to develop healthy identities, manage emotions and achieve personal and collective goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain supportive relationships, and make responsible and caring decisions. (CASEL's updated 2020 definition of SEL)

Vision for Student Success

We believe all students deserve access to equitable supports which build their emotional, social, cognitive development using research-based strategies which promote the needs of the whole child to produce well-rounded graduates who persevere through challenges, think critically and use Social Emotional Competencies to advocate and advance their growth and development.

Why Social Emotional Learning in MSCS?

We believe educators can create classroom and school cultures that provide opportunities for students to learn and practice the social and emotional competencies that are closely linked to academic achievement as well as success in the workplace and in life.

What is SEL Week 2024?

SEL4US and The Urban Assembly are celebrating around the world in the fourth annual International SEL Week, March 4 - 8, 2024. This year, Memphis-Shelby County Schools (MSCS) will be participating in activities throughout the entire week. The theme for this year is *Uplifting Hearts, Connecting Minds*. The toolkit provided from SEL4US, and the Urban Assembly has been modified to include additional resources that have been provided by the MSCS SEL team. The provided resources focus on all areas of social emotional learning.

Recently, several traumatic events have occurred around our city that have affected many of our students and families in the communities where we work, learn, live and play. Social emotional learning is needed now, more than ever! Research is showing that students who benefit from SEL programs are likely to benefit academically and are better equipped to handle challenges. Join us for SEL Week 2024 where we will examine the 5 CASEL Competencies.

What is CASEL? CASEL is the Collaborative for Academic, Social, and Emotional Learning, the world's leading organization advancing one of the most important fields in education. It is also defined as the process through which all young people and adults acquire and apply the knowledge, skills, and attitudes to develop healthy identities, manage emotions and achieve personal and collective goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain supportive relationships, and make responsible and caring decisions. Take a moment to review the CASEL Wheel which includes all 5 Competencies. (CASEL, 2020)



Directions: Students will be introduced to **one** competency each day and wear the color assigned to each competency. For morning announcements, a selected student or school personnel will read the competency definition and a scenario that aligns with the concept. Each classroom will take 5-7 minutes to brainstorm a solution to the questions following the scenario.

Monday (Wear Green) CASEL Competency: Self-Awareness

Tuesday (Wear Blue) CASEL Competency: Self- Management
